### HOLY TRINITY CHURCH GUIDELINES

**LENTEN PREPARATION PROGRAM** - Pride, envy, anger, sloth, greed, gluttony and lust: these “seven deadly sins” are patterns of dysfunction that keep us separated from God and ultimately lead to unhappiness. Join us as we embark on Fr. Robert Barron’s exploration of these seven sinful patterns and also learn how practicing countervailing virtues can break the cycle of sin. Beginning February 10, our parish has been invited to join with Bishop Barron and Deacon Jim Doyle to begin the 8-week Seven Deadly Sins and Seven Lively Virtues program via ZOOM on Wednesdays at 10:00 a.m. For more information, contact Deacon Jim (717 343-1102) or stop by the parish office to sign up.

This ministry was formed to assist men and women getting out of prison and their families to negotiate their way on the spiritual journey through the many barriers which exist to their reintegration into the community and the Church. **SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM** - Baptism classes are held the second Sunday of each month at 6:00 p.m. in the rectory basement and Baptisms are held the first Sunday of the month at 12:00 noon. Please contact the Parish Office at (717) 684-2711 to schedule a mandatory appointment with Father beforehand to start the process.

1. If you have concerns about your health or your vulnerability to infection, please stay home. Mass will continue to be live-streamed and recorded.
2. Everyone over 2 years old must wear masks (unless excused for medical necessity) at all times in the church and office, except for receiving communion. Gloves are not permitted for receiving communion in the hand.
3. Confessions will be offered in the church, in the right side sacristy, at the usual time (3:30-4:30 pm Saturdays). Please keep your mask on.
4. Every other pew is roped off. Please do not move the ropes.
5. Please do not socialize within the building before or after Mass.
6. Please keep social distance in the pews, in procession to receive communion, and at all other times. People who live together do not need to keep social distance from one another.
7. There will not be a collection taken. There will be a place to donate your offering near each of the doors. Thank you for your continued generosity.
8. **Volunteers are needed to wipe down pews and commonly touched objects in the church after each weekend Mass.**
9. During this green phase, we are able to have altar servers, but not extraordinary ministers, nor distributing the Precious Blood or sharing the Sign of Peace. Extraordinary Ministers may take communion to the home-bound, with required masks and social distancing.
10. Please refrain from congregational singing.
